If using copy feature a series of buttons will appear around your job image, select where you want the copies to be placed and use the copy slider for spacing between original and copies. You can also “lock” your original if doing rotate, size etc on the copies.

If rotating your slider in the middle at “0” does nothing, slider to the left rotates counter clockwise and slider to the right rotates clockwise.

Similar with size slider, slider in the middle does no size adjustments. Slider to the left makes image smaller by percentage and to the right makes bigger by given percentage.

If using move function a series of arrows will appear around your image to allow the direction of the move in mm to be selected.

Note:

Remember any edit made you want to try over again can be reversed with the “Undo” button shown above.
