Browsing your collection of saved jobs is straight forward with easy to use controls.

If you wish to delete a saved job click the trash icon and your selected saved job is deleted, when not using “Browse Saved Jobs” the trash can icon normally deletes the job in the selected job folder.

After recalling a job click green arrow in upper left corner of panel to return to your job folder.

This same green arrow is found on all the panels within Tux Plot.

If edits are done that you want to save by updating the saved job, select “Save Job” button and point to the same file name and it will warn you of over writing it, overwrite to update the job.
