A memo can be very useful on a complex job that you may want to repeat someday and not waste time setting everything up again. A memo can contain reminders and tips you may need to help save time in replicating the job fast.

Your memo is NOT saved unless you use the "Save Job" function in the top left row of icons. When your job is recalled at a later date your memo is also recalled. To view a memo click memo icon for selected job folder 1-4.

Launch memo creation panel by selecting "Panel View" and select edit/create job memo. A data memo also found in "Panel View" is a more detailed memo with settings used for the job with a place at the end for personal text.
